

Recycling for Guadalupe County Residents

Guadalupe County contracts with Bexar Waste to operate three Collection Stations with free recycling of plastic and glass containers, cans, paper and flattened cardboard.

Fees apply to dispose of household trash, appliances, bulky items, construction debris, brush, Styrofoam, roofing materials and tires. Some charges are determined by volume, so the more compact your load, the lower your fee. What to Recycle at County Collection Stations at no charge:

- ✓ Cardboard and boxboard, flattened and dry
- ✓ Waste paper and junk mail
- ✓ Rinsed plastic containers with recycling symbols #1-7
- ✓ Rinsed glass bottles and jars only.
- ✓ Rinsed tin and aluminum cans

Seguin – Tuesday-Saturday 8:30 am - 4:30 pm

How to Recycle:

1. Always see the attendant first before unloading items.
2. Prepare your recyclables properly by washing or rinsing all containers. Cardboard must be flattened.
3. County residents may mix glass and plastic recyclables together. Tin and aluminum cans are collected separately.
4. Deposit recyclables loose into collection container. No plastic trash bags allowed in recycling trailers.

Not Accepted:

1. No hazardous materials and no appliances with Freon
2. No plastic bags in recycling trailers
3. No wet paint cans
