

Voting By Mail

[Applications for a ballot by mail](#) must be received by the Elections Office no later than 11 days before the election.

You may vote by mail if you are:

- Going to be away from your county on Election Day and during Early Voting (the ballot will need to be mailed to an out of county address in this instance)
- Disabled
- 65 years of age or older on Election Day
- Confined in jail, but eligible to vote

If an Application for Ballot by Mail is emailed or faxed to the Early Voting Clerk, the original application must be received by mail within 4 days for the emailed/faxed application to be valid. If the original application is received after the 4th day, it becomes effective on the date it is received.
