Three additional cases of COVID-19 reported in Guadalupe County.

Three additional COVID-19 cases have been confirmed in Guadalupe County, bringing the total cases to 26. The Texas Department of State Health Services made Guadalupe County Office of Emergency Management aware of these additional cases Friday, April 3, 2020.

All three patients are at home and have been self-quarantined since being tested. There was no exposure to any public places with these three patients.

We continue to encourage and recommend all citizens to help stop and slow the spread of COVID-19 by following the guidelines outlined by the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Effective April 3, 2020, 11:59 pm, In conjunction with the Executive Order from Governor Abbott's office, Judge Kutscher has signed a Stay Home Stay Safe order for Guadalupe County. In addition, the Disaster Declaration has also been updated to reflect the new order. Stay home unless you must leave for an essential job or activity, which is outlined in the order.

The Texas Department of State Health Services confirmed the recovery of three COVID-19 patients in Guadalupe County as of April 3rd. Currently, there are 20 active cases, and six recovered cases within the county.
