Guadalupe County confirms 65th case of COVID-19 with 45 patients now recovered

One additional COVID-19 case has been confirmed in Guadalupe County, bringing the total cases to 65. The Texas Department of State Health Services made Guadalupe County Office of Emergency Management aware of this additional case Thursday, April 22, 2020.

Guadalupe County currently has 45 recovered patients, 20 active cases, with one patient being hospitalized outside of the County and the second hospitalized patient located in Guadalupe County. Today's patients is at home and has been self-quarantined since being tested.

Given the increases in the community spread throughout the United States, all individuals are at some risk of exposures to COVID-19. Everyone should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19, practice social distancing, and stay home if they become sick, except to seek necessary medical care.

Guadalupe County was able to test 43 patients in the City of Schertz drive thru testing site on April, 22, 2020.
