Guadalupe County confirms 80th case of COVID-19 with 48 patients now recovered

Seven additional COVID-19 cases have been confirmed in Guadalupe County, bringing the total cases to 80. The Texas Department of State Health Services made Guadalupe County Office of Emergency Management aware of these additional cases Tuesday, April 28, 2020.

Given the increases in the community spread throughout the United States, all individuals are at some risk of exposures to COVID-19. Everyone should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19, practice social distancing, and stay home if they become sick, except to seek necessary medical care.
