For Immediate Release:

223 People have recovered from COVID-19 in Guadalupe County with 61 active cases.

9 COVID-19 cases have been confirmed in Guadalupe County since Tuesday, June 23rd, bringing the total cases reported to 284. **Multiple** cases are in the same households.

Effective June 19, 2020

The Texas Department of State Health services changed their new reporting format for COVID. The total county will include the total of confirmed, probable, and pending cases in Guadalupe County.

The total case in count will also be the same as the sum of active, recovered, and death cases:

Pending Investigation + Confirmed + Probable = Total = Active + Recovered + Deaths

284 Reported to Guadalupe County + 237 DSHS Pending Cases = DSHS 521 total reported on website.

Reminder on Case Definitions

A confirmed case of COVID-19 is one that is laboratory confirmed in a clinical specimen using a molecular test, such as a PCR test. A probable case of COVID-19 is one that is not laboratory confirmed by PCR, but may meet case definition through a combination of symptoms, exposure history, and other lab tests. The purpose of a probable case definition is to identify cases that may not be able to receive a confirmatory test. This may be due to their isolation status or because they have mild symptoms that do not require a healthcare visit. Both confirmed and probable cases are considered cases and are included in total counts.

We continue to encourage and recommend all citizens to help stop and slow the spread of COVID-19 by following the guidelines outlined by the Texas Department of State Health Services and orders issued by the Governor or local jurisdictions.
