For Immediate Release:

54 new COVID-19 cases have been confirmed and reported in Guadalupe County since Thursday, July 8th.

609 total reported to Guadalupe County + 470 DSHS PENDING cases = DSHS website total of **1079**

406 people have recovered from COVID-19 in Guadalupe County, with 203 **confirmed** active cases.

HOSPITALIZATIONS

We are in constant communication with the hospital. We are aware that there are more COVID-19 patients at GRMC than what our chart shows. We can only “officially” report confirmed cases by DSHS and we can only count patients that reside within Guadalupe County. Currently, **GRMC has 33** hospitalized patients at their facility. Not all of these patients reside in Guadalupe County.

Texas Department of State Health Services has only officially notified the Emergency Management Office of 4 hospitalized patients.

DEATHS

Chart Update

Guadalupe County is continuing to provide the most up to date information on COVID-19 cases. The Emergency Management Office is tracking the data supplied by DSHS and updating the charts as we receive it. The data is provided by DSHS twice a day, and the table is changing all of the time. In efforts to ensure the data reflects the numbers provided, we will give the chart information during the Commissioners Court.

Guadalupe County will also be meeting with the Mayor of all cities in Guadalupe County to discuss better methods of providing information to their communities early next week.
