For Immediate Release:

81 new COVID-19 cases have been confirmed and reported in Guadalupe County since Monday, July 13th.

748 total reported to Guadalupe County + 426 DSHS PENDING cases = DSHS website total of **1,174**

467 people have recovered from COVID-19 in Guadalupe County, with 281 **confirmed** active cases.

HOSPITALIZATIONS

We are in constant communication with the hospital. We are aware that there are more COVID-19 patients at GRMC than what our chart shows. We can only “officially” report confirmed cases by DSHS, and we can only count patients that reside within Guadalupe County. Currently, **GRMC has 38** hospitalized patients at their facility. Not all of these patients reside in Guadalupe County.

Texas Department of State Health Services notified Guadalupe County of two additional hospitalized patients. One patient is hospitalized in Guadalupe County, and the second is hospitalized in a hospital in Austin.

DEATHS

Just like with any other case, there is a verification process that DSHS must perform before death can be confirmed as a COVID-19 related death. It isn't until that process is completed that we can “officially” account for the death. DSHS has officially notified Guadalupe County of **3** deaths, and we were informed on July 13, 2020, by GRMC that there have been three new deaths related to COVID-19. The total deaths reported to the Emergency Management Office at our local hospital is **16**. Not all of these patients reside in Guadalupe County.

Chart Update
