### For Immediate Release:

42 new cases have been added to the active section of the chart. These are confirmed positive or probable cases. Guadalupe county has 164 probable cases which are not included in this chart.

### HOSPITALIZATIONS:

GRMC is reporting 6 hospitalized patients at this time. Not all hospitalized patients are Guadalupe County residence.

### DEATHS:

Since the start of COVID-19, there have been 40 deaths reported to Guadalupe County Emergency Management by DSHS. Guadalupe County expects the number of deaths to increase due to the Texas Department of State Health Services webpage reporting 59 deaths. Due to the lag in the reporting, we have not yet been provided all of the deaths.
