Guadalupe County Historic Courthouse and Guadalupe County Justice Center; along with other county buildings/offices are closed to in-person traffic

The Historic Courthouse and other Guadalupe County offices are closing to foot traffic in an effort to protect the public and county employees from potential exposure to the novel coronavirus.

In all cases, the offices remain open and are available by phone and email to handle public inquiries and provide direction to possible online resources. The county's main switchboard number is 830-303-4188; it also remains open.
