CEO Report Oct 2019-Sep 2020 Executive Summary

American Job Center Traffic

COVID-19 Stay at Home orders led to center closures in the month of March and continued through August. A total of 14,018 customers were served in the month of September. 9,260 through our Call Centers, 4,758 via email. The Urban/Rural breakdown was 74%(10,393) in our Urban centers and 26% (3,625) in the surrounding counties.

Units of Service

Using formula-funds (WIOA grants, Choices, NCP Choices, SNAP, and TAA), Center Staff certified and provided services to an estimated 5,114 youth and adults during the 2020 Program Year (October 2019-September 2020). Year-to-date, staff provided about 34,600 units of services to these job seekers and universal customers (those not enrolled in a program). These services include informational services, lifeskills, job search, pre-employment activities, work experience, subsidized employment, occupational vocational training, job search services, education, support services, follow-up, and others.

Labor Exchange – Employers

Labor exchange data shows that there are 7,163 active employers in WorkInTexas.com as of September 2020.

Labor Exchange – Job Orders

Labor exchange data shows that there were 25,499 job orders created by 2,279 unique employers in WorkInTexas.com during the months of October 2019-September 2020 for the 13 county Workforce Development Area. HCA Healthcare is the employer with the most Job Orders with 2,058 while the occupation with the greatest number of job orders is Registered Nurse with 2,148.

Labor Market Exchange – Job Seekers

Year to date Labor exchange data shows that in the Alamo area there are 127,343 candidates with active resumes in WorkInTexas.com as of September 2020.

Labor Market Exchange – Placements

In terms of placements, year to date the workforce development system successfully matched 7,996 job seekers and employers during the months of October 2019-September 2020. Additionally, 3,675 job seekers Went to Work (job seekers that find work on their own) during the same time period. Bringing the total number of WorkInTexas.com placements to 11,671.




AREA UNEMPLOYMENT RATES SNAPSHOT




GUADALUPE COUNTY UNEMPLOYMENT RATE INCREASES TO 6.3 PERCENT





Bexar County Precincts







Training Services


