Separate sealed bids for **“GUADALUPE COUNTY ARCHIVES – 212 W. NOLTE ST. BUILDING IMPROVEMENT”** will be received at the County Judge Office, Hon. Mike Wiggins, Guadalupe County Courthouse, 307 West Court St., Ste. 200, Seguin, TX 78155 until 2:00 p.m., Monday, July 10, 2008. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. Any bids received after closing time will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened.

In a separate sealed envelope, the Contractor shall furnish Contractor's Statement of Qualifications, as defined on Page S1-2 and same, must accompany all bids. Any bids submitted without the Statement of Qualifications shall not be opened and will be returned unopened to the Contractor. The information contained in the Statement of Qualifications will not be released to the general public or anyone not legally requiring such information.

The project is for the expansion of archive storage within an existing County owned warehouse at 212 W. Nolte St. The approximate 48' x 60' elevated storage mezzanine is to be constructed of a steel frame with a concrete deck.

The Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Form of Contract, Specifications, Forms of Bid Bond, Performance and Payment Bond and other contract documents may be examined at the office of Kirk Gregory Engineering, Inc. 726 Zipp Road, New Braunfels, TX 78130-9048 (tel. 830-629-8075). Copies may be obtained at the office of the Engineer upon payment of \$50.00 per set. There is an additional \$10.00 non-refundable mailing fee for each requested set.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid issued by an acceptable surety. A certified check or bank draft made payable to the Owner may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. Bids must be submitted on forms furnished. No bid may be withdrawn for 30 days after the above scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

The Owner may reject any and/or all bids, and waive any formalities in bidding. In determining to whom to award the bid, the Owner may consider all relevant factors and circumstances, which the law allows to be considered.
